Subject: Education for refugee children

According to several NGOs, almost 500 000 children out of the millions who have fled their homes due to persecution and conflict, have still not been registered in any school system, in spite of funds and projects from the EU and NGOs. Ensuring that all refugee minors go to school and have the same rights as any other child from the host country is essential and can prevent radicalisation and violence.

How does the Commission intend to ensure that enrolment and education policies are properly implemented?

What instruments does the Commission have at its disposal to monitor the crisis in the provision of education to refugees in order to avoid any exploitative forms of child labour or child marriage in the host country?
