Subject: Gender mainstreaming strategy

Gender mainstreaming means 'the integration of a gender perspective into every aspect of EU policy - preparation, design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of policies, legal measures and spending programmes - with a view to achieving equality between women and men'<sup>1</sup>. Since Parliament adopted a resolution on gender mainstreaming in 2003<sup>2</sup>, each parliamentary committee has appointed one of its members to be responsible for gender mainstreaming.

Does the Commission have a similar gender mainstreaming strategy for its work, or does it plan to implement one?
