Subject: Islamic exhibition in Brussels

Recently, the exhibition 'Islam, this is also our history!' opened in Brussels. At a time when virtually every day Islamic terrorism is occurring somewhere in Europe, a promotion campaign for this intolerant, violent ideology is not appropriate.

1. Is it true that the exhibition 'Islam, this is also our history!' is being co-financed by the Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency (EACEA), which has commissioned it?
2. How can the Commission reasonably fund an exhibition on Islam when 99% of terrorist murders in 2015 and 95% of terrorist murders in 2016 were committed by adherents of that very religion?
3. Does the Commission agree that the most prominent feature of our shared history with Islam is bloody Islamic terror against innocent citizens? If not, why not?
