Subject: Quality of education

An analysis of primary education in the Member States has shown that the average minimum teaching time in Europe is 734 hours per school year. However, this varies from one country to the next, from 486 hours per year at the lower end to 1051 hours per year in Denmark.

- Does the Commission feel that there may be a correlation between the average number of hours of primary education and the quality of education?
- In this connection, is the Commission preparing measures or recommendations?
