Subject: Tackling child hunger in schools

In some Member States there are still children that go to school hungry or that do not receive proper allocations for their needs.

There are significant differences between Member State programmes for child education and health.

Recognising that all children should benefit from equal treatment, including decent allocations and healthy school meals, and taking into account that there should be harmonised rules and rights for children at EU level, is the Commission considering tackling the deficiency of proper meals in EU schools?
