Subject: The murder of Giulio Regeni

It is now approaching two years since Giulio Regeni, an Italian Cambridge University PhD student, was abducted and tortured to death in Egypt where he was conducting research into the country's independent trade unions. As yet no-one has been arrested or charged with Giulio Regeni's murder and there are still too many unanswered questions regarding his death.

1. What action can the Commission take to get justice for Giulio Regeni?
2. What further steps can be taken to ensure the safety of academics studying in Egypt?
3. What can be done to increase the pressure on the Egyptian Government to ensure that the perpetrators of Giulio Regeni's murder do not escape prosecution?
