Subject: Roaming charges

In June 2016, the regulation ending roaming charges came into force. This was a major step forward, allowing EU citizens to take full advantage of mobile communications and digital services when travelling to other Member States.

With a view to assessing the impact of this measure in the months following its implementation, could the Commission say whether it is aware that domestic charges have been raised to offset hypothetical losses caused by the abolition of roaming charges? Has the Commission noticed the emergence of specific tariffs that do not include roaming? What is the Commission doing to ensure that this regulation is being properly implemented?
