Subject: Is the Union able to affect Apple's pricing scheme (for example for computers) in Europe?

In Finland, the price for Apple's 27 inch iMac (MNE92), worth EUR 2 200, varies between shops of different chains up to a 20 cent difference. When asked, the retailers say that Apple defines the prices.

Does Union legislation currently allow for companies to dictate the price of their products in a way that impedes fair competition?
