## Question for written answer E-000207/2018/rev.1 to the Commission

Subject: Use of military force against the civilian population

On 6 January 2018, the Spanish Defence Minister, María Dolores de Cospedal, acknowledged that the Spanish army had been on standby to intervene in Catalonia for months<sup>1</sup>.

Ms Cospedal also praised the role played by the Spanish army, claiming that it had demonstrated its 'excellent credentials in terms of democracy and upholding civilian rule' as regards maintaining Spain's territorial integrity.

Bearing in mind the acts of violence perpetrated by the Spanish security forces against voters in Catalonia on 1 October 2017:

- 1. What is the Commission's view with regard to the question of whether possible military action against civilians engaged in peaceful protest is consistent with Article 2 of the Treaty on European Union<sup>3</sup>?
- 2. How, in the Commission's view, are Articles 2 and 4<sup>4,5</sup> of the Treaty on European Union compatible with one another where there is a clear threat of a Member State using military force against its own people?
