Subject: Health and care in the Digital Single Market

Digital innovation can improve the promotion of health, the prevention of disease and access to care, and play a part in making healthcare systems more resilient and sustainable. In its 2017 mid-term review of the Digital Single Market, the Commission said that it would address the need for measures in the area of digital health and care, in line with legislation on the protection of personal data, patient rights and electronic identification. For instance, it stated that it was working with Member States to ensure that citizens could transfer their basic medical information electronically when having treatment in another Member State and use e-prescriptions to collect their medication.
