## Question for written answer E-001148/2018 to the Commission Rule 130 Dominique Martin (ENF)

Subject: High concentration of asylum seekers in one location slowing down the integration

process

On 1 January 2016, 35.1 million people born outside the EU were living in an EU Member State. On 24 January 2018, the Commission published an English-language toolkit on the use of EU funds for the integration of people with a migrant background. In that guide, the Commission states that a high concentration of asylum seekers in one location slows down the integration process (pp.17 and 23)<sup>1</sup>.

1. In the Commission's view, above what threshold does the term 'high concentration' apply?

2. How are these thresholds calculated in terms of unemployment rates, school class sizes and housing capacity?
