Subject: Preferential treatment of native people in New Caledonia and French Polynesia in the area of employment

Are the native people in New Caledonia and French Polynesia being given preferential treatment over more recent settlers, in the form of priority access to state or private jobs?

Does the Commission take the view that favouring the employment of native people makes economic and cultural development possible?
