Subject: Climate action budget

In its Special Report No 31/2016, the Court of Auditors (ECA) warned of the serious risk that the target of investing 20% of the budget into climate action and tackling global warming would not be met. The ECA stated that, according to Commission figures, the share of funding dedicated to climate action was 17.6% between 2014 and 2016 and that, in the future, it would rise to 18.9%.

Accordingly, the ECA issued a set of recommendations to ensure the target of 20% is met, including conducting an annual review to assess the extent to which these recommendations are being followed. What steps has the Commission taken in response to these recommendations?
