Subject: Situation in Guatemala

On 3 June 2018 Guatemala's Fuego volcano, one of Central America's most active volcanos, erupted. As of this writing, at least 69 persons have died as a result of this natural disaster, and at least 46 persons have been injured. In response to the volcanic eruption, the Commission has activated the EU's satellite-based Copernicus Emergency Management Service – Mapping in order to help with search and rescue operations.

In addition to activating the satellite mapping service, does the Commission envisage providing further assistance to the families of the victims and to the reconstruction efforts in the affected villages?
