## Question for written answer E-003547/2018 to the Commission <br> Rule 130 <br> Dominique Martin (ENF)

Subject: French nationals under-represented in the Commission
According to a Commission report of 18 June 2018, the French make up $15 \%$ of the EU's 443 million inhabitants (excluding the United Kingdom). However, they account for only 8\% of the Commission's administrators at the standard grades ${ }^{1}$ and fewer than $5 \%$ of its translators ${ }^{2}$. There are 712 Romanian and Bulgarian administrators, compared with just 353 French.

Furthermore, a French Senate report ${ }^{3}$ revealed that there were no French nationals among the Commission's senior management responsible for the main policies under the European budget, such as agriculture and regional policy ${ }^{4}$, which accounted for around $70 \%$ of the budget in $2017^{5}$. Overall, all of the net budget contributors are under-represented.

Under the Staff Regulations, recruitment shall be directed to securing for the institution the services of officials of the highest standard of ability, recruited on the broadest possible geographical basis from among nationals of Member States of the Union ${ }^{6}$.

Why is the Commission not undertaking a specific recruitment programme for French nationals to address the significant imbalance it found ${ }^{7}$ ?
