Subject: European Labour Authority

According to a proposal by the Commission, the European Labour Authority (ELA) will replace six structures, namely: the Technical Committee on the Free Movement of Workers, the Committee of Experts on Posting of Workers, the Technical Commission of the Administrative Commission for the Coordination of Social Security Systems, the Audit Board of the Administrative Commission for the Coordination of Social Security Systems and the European Platform tackling undeclared work. However, the proposal is not clear on the issue of the tasks to be taken over by the new Authority.

In light of the transparency principle, could the Commission clarify the tasks that will be taken over by the ELA and how the latter will collaborate with the various commissions and committees that will continue to exist?
