Subject: Infringement proceedings related to the transposition of Directive 2010/63/EU

The Commission has opened infringement proceedings against 10 Member States related to the transposition of Directive 2010/63/EU into their national law¹.

On 16 July 2018, Martin Häusling (Verts/ALE) tabled a question (E-003938/2018) requesting information on what is happening in some of these Member States and asking what the Commission's intentions are regarding the complaints about the incorrect transposition of Directive 2010/63/EU in Germany².

Prior to this, in reply to a question (P-000292-18) by Younous Omarjee (GUE/NGL), the Commission gave an update on which Member States were still subject to infringement proceedings and which processes were closed³.

However, it is still not clear what the complaints of the Commission are against the ten Member States concerned regarding their transposition of Directive 2010/63/EU into their national law.

Can the Commission provide a detailed description of its current complaints against each of these 10 Member States?

Can it also give information on the state of the infringement proceedings for each Member State?
