Can the Commission please supply a copy of the current guidelines relating to the process and methodology behind the sifting, prioritisation and non-pursuit of cases put before OLAF or otherwise encountered by anti-fraud elements and desks otherwise associated with combating corruption? What thresholds of claimed loss currently have to be met, by area of expenditure, for an investigation to be authorised and pursued?
