Subject: Reorganisation of the Commission's services

Under Article 17(6)(b) of the Treaty on European Union (TEU), 'the President of the Commission shall decide on the internal organisation of the Commission, ensuring that it acts consistently, efficiently and as a collegiate body'.

In recent weeks, it has been suggested that the Secretary-General of the Commission, Martin Selmayr, is already drafting a proposal for the reorganisation of the Commission's services to present to the new President for approval.

Given that Parliament may also potentially be restructured, information on this proposal would be vital in order to better organise this restructuring and reform Parliament's rules and procedures in accordance with any changes made at Commission level.

Could the Commission therefore make such draft proposals available to Parliament, or at least to its Conference of Presidents?
