Subject: Textiles in the circular economy

Given its high environmental impact and with the consumption of textiles estimated to double by 2030, together with very low material recovery rates, moving the textiles sector away from 'fast fashion' and towards more sustainable and circular value chains presents the opportunity to deliver substantially better economic, societal and environmental outcomes for the textiles sector across the EU.
