


SUGGESTIONS

The Committee on Employment and Social Affairs calls on the Committee on Budgetary Control, as the committee responsible, to incorporate the following suggestions into its motion for a resolution:

- 1. Expresses its satisfaction that the Court of Auditors has declared the transactions underlying the Foundation's annual accounts for the financial year 2015 to be legal and regular and that its financial position as at 31 December 2015 is fairly represented;
- 2. Acknowledges the Foundation's progress in the implementation of the current four-year programme for 2013 to 2016 on research to assist the development of social and labour policies; welcomes its input to policy development through a consistently high number of quality surveys, studies, presentations, events and projects in order to constantly improve the living and working conditions in the Union; notes the start of the European Parliament's pilot project, 'The future of manufacturing in Europe'; considers it to be important to maintain strong cooperation between the Foundation and the Committee on Employment and Social Affairs in order to continue to engage in constructive and evidence-based discussions; calls on the Foundation to continue to closely monitor, analyse and report on living and working conditions and to provide expertise for their improvement;
- 3. Notes the high-level impact of the Foundation, particularly in supporting the Union institutions, as reflected in the performance indicators presented in the consolidated annual activity report;
- 4. Strongly commends the high budget implementation rate in 2015 (99,9%) and the good overall target delivery;
- 5. Notes that the level of committed appropriations carried over to 2016 was high for Title III (31,2 % compared to 53,7 % in 2014); notes that this is mainly related to multi-annual projects implemented according to schedule; stresses, however, that further efforts are needed to meet the target of a timely delivery of planned activities;
- 6. Welcomes the Foundation's follow-up measures in relation to the comments of the discharge authority made regarding the implementation of the budget of previous years;
- 7. Welcomes the conclusion of a headquarters agreement between Ireland and the Foundation in November 2015.
