The joint LIBE/JURI meeting opened at 9.06 on Thursday, 21 March 2019, with Claude Moraes (Chair) presiding.

2. Adoption of agenda

On 14 March 2019, the Parliament received Draft Commission delegated regulation (EU) supplementing Regulation (EU) No 515/2014 with regard to the allocation of funding from the general budget of the Union to cover the costs for the development of the European Travel Information and Authorisation System.

The basic act is Regulation (EU) No 515/2014 with regard to the allocation of

funding from the general budget of the Union to cover the costs for the development of the European Travel Information and Authorisation System.

The deadline to raise an objection was set before 28 March at 12.00.

b) Implementing Acts:

a) On 12 March 2019, the Parliament received four Draft Commission Implementing acts with basic act is Regulation (EU) 2018/1240 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 12 September 2018 establishing a European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS) and amending Regulations (EU) No 1077/2011, (EU) No 515/2014, (EU) 2016/399, (EU) 2016/1624 and (EU) 2017/2226.

The four implementing acts are the following:

- Draft Commission Implementing Decision laying down standard form for refusal, annulment or revocation of a travel authorisation pursuant to Article 38(3) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1240.
- Draft Commission Implementing Decision laying down requirements on the format of personal data to be inserted in the application form as well as on the parameters and the verifications to be implemented in order to ensure completeness of the application and coherence of the data.
- Draft Commission Implementing Decision on the keeping and accessing of the logs in the European Travel Information and Authorisation System (ETIAS), pursuant to Article 73(3)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1240.
- Draft Commission Implementing Decision on the specifications for technical solutions to connect central access points to the ETIAS Central System and for a technical solution to facilitate the collection of data by Member States and Europol for the purpose of generating statistics on the access to the ETIAS data for law enforcement purposes, pursuant to Article 73(3)(b) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1240.

The reception of these implementing acts was communicated to all LIBE Members via the LIBE DIA Newsletter of 15 March 2019 and an internal deadline for proposing an objection was set. 26 March 2019 at 12:00.

b) On 12 March 2019, the Parliament received Draft Commission Implementing Decision laying down detailed rules on the information to be provided to the European Commission by the Member States regarding the stamping of travel documents in the exceptional situation where it is technically impossible to enter data in both the Entry/Exit Central System and in the National Uniform Interface and it is technically impossible to temporarily store the data locally in an electronic format.

The basic act is Regulation (EU) 2017/2226 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 30 November 2017 establishing an Entry/Exit System (EES) to register entry and exit data and refusal of entry data of third-country nationals crossing the external borders of the Member States and determining the conditions for access to the EES for law enforcement purposes, and amending the

Convention implementing the Schengen Agreement and Regulations (EC) No 767/2008 and (EU) No 1077/2011.
