

Ordinary legislative procedure (★★★III)
majority of votes cast to approve a joint text

2. Consent

- Consent procedure (★★★)
where the Treaties require a majority of Parliament's component Members to adopt or reject a decision giving consent

3. Second reading

- Ordinary legislative procedure (★★★II)
majority of Parliament's component Members to reject or amend the Council position; majority of votes cast to approve the
Council position

4. Parliament's Rules of Procedure

 Amendments to Rules of Procedure majority of Parliament's component Members to adopt amendments majority of votes cast to adopt a proposal for a decision

5. First reading

Ordinary legislative procedure (★★★I)
majority of votes cast to approve or amend a legislative proposal
