

Unless Parliament decides otherwise, texts taken in plenary will be put to the vote in the following order

#### 1. Third reading

 Ordinary legislative procedure (★★★III) majority of votes cast to approve a joint text

#### 2. Consent

- Consent procedure (★★★)
where the Treaties require a majority of Parliament's component Members to adopt or reject a decision giving consent

#### 3. Second reading

Ordinary legislative procedure (★★★II)
majority of Parliament's component Members to reject or amend the Council position; majority of votes cast to approve the
Council position

#### 4. Parliament's Rules of Procedure

 Amendments to Rules of Procedure majority of Parliament's component Members to adopt amendments majority of votes cast to adopt a proposal for a decision

#### 5. First reading

- Ordinary legislative procedure (★★★I)
majority of votes cast to approve or amend a legislative proposal
majority of votes cast to adopt a draft legislative resolution

#### 6. Consent

Consent procedure (★★★)
 where the Treaties require a majority of votes cast to adopt or reject a decision giving consent

#### 7. Other procedures

- Consultation procedure (\*)
  majority of votes cast to approve or amend a legislative proposal
  majority of votes cast to adopt a draft legislative resolution
- Others (statements, oral questions, own-initiative reports, waiver of immunity) majority of votes cast to adopt a motion for a resolution or a proposal for a decision
