Subject: Implementation of EU law in Italy

The Italian Presidency of the Council has presented an ambitious programme for the second half of 2014, which provides, inter alia, for greater flexibility.

At the same time, the new Commission is expected to take office on 1 November 2014. Can the current Commission answer the following questions?

1. What is the current state of play as regards the implementation of EU law in the 28 Member States, and what is the current state of play in this regard in Italy?
2. How many legal acts have been fully implemented/transposed in Italy, and in the case of how many does the Commission have doubts about their implementation/transposition? In the case of how many legal acts has the Commission brought infringement proceedings against Italy?
3. What priority has the implementation of EU legal acts enjoyed in the past five years?
