Question for written answer P-006720/2014 to the Commission Rule 130 Werner Langen (PPE)

Subject: Town twinning

Town twinning has been one of the activities promoted by the Europe for Citizens programme (under 'Action 1 – Active Citizens for Europe'). In 2007, EU wide, more than 50% of the applications for support for twinning schemes were approved. The corresponding figure in 2013 was barely 15%. The approval rate in Germany in 2013 was approximately 20%¹.

The total funding allocated to the programme in the period 2007-2013 was EUR 215 million.

At least 45% of this (i.e. EUR 96.75 million) was earmarked for 'Action 1'.

- 1. How many applications under the four areas of action were submitted and how many were approved, both in the EU as a whole and in Germany (in each of the years 2007-2013 and also in 2014 (year (n+1))?
- 2. What percentages of the available funding for each area of action were spent, both in the EU as a whole and in Germany?
- 3. Why were so many applications rejected, both in the EU as a whole and in Germany, and what were the main grounds for rejecting them?
