Question for written answer P-010349/2014 to the Commission Rule 130 Ilhan Kyuchyuk (ALDE)

Subject: Action on non-reciprocity of visas between the USA and Bulgaria

On 10 October 2014, the Commission published its annual report 'assessing the situation of non-reciprocity with certain third countries in the area of visa policy', which outlines the current state of affairs as regards tripartite discussions on visa reciprocity; however, there were no clear indications as to what concrete action the Commission will take to address the non-reciprocity of visas between the USA and Bulgaria. The visa refusal rate for Bulgarian citizens in 2013 was 19.9 %.

- 1. How does the Commission intend to address the fact that the principle of equal treatment of EU citizens is currently being breached as a result of the lack of visa reciprocity for Bulgarians, Romanians, Cypriots and Poles wishing to travel to the USA?
- 2. Is the Commission planning to demand full visa liberalisation for the USA for all 28 Member States as part of the negotiations on a possible Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP) agreement?
