Subject: Subsidies awarded in connection with the Nürburgring redevelopment project

On 1 October 2014, the Commission decided that most of the subsidies awarded in connection with the Nürburgring redevelopment project were illegal and that no objections could now be raised to the sale of the company which owns the Nürburgring, which is insolvent. As at 13 January 2015, however, the Commission decision has still not been published.

1. When will the Commission publish its decision, and what is the explanation for the unusually lengthy period which has elapsed between the Commission taking its decision and the publication of that decision?
2. How is the Commission dealing with the complaints lodged by the unsuccessful tenderers?
3. Has the Rhineland-Palatinate Government been asked to give its opinion on the complaints lodged by the unsuccessful tenderers? If so, in what form has it done so?
