Subject: Catalan law on cinema in Catalan

Further to the three questions previously put to the Commission on this matter (E-007389/2010, E-007567/2011 and E-013742/2013).

Thirty-two months after the reasoned opinion was sent, and 13 months after the Commission's latest answer, the measures outlined in that answer have not been adopted, nor has the new Commission gone ahead with infringement proceedings as stated in its answer, despite the insistence of the sector.

At a time when economic circumstances are particularly difficult, this failure to bring Catalan regulations into line with EU law is seriously detrimental to businesses in the sector. The Commission has an obligation to guarantee compliance with the treaties, and we are therefore of the opinion that action on its part is necessary.

- 1. What action is the Commission planning to take?
- 2. When is the Commission planning to take this matter to the European Court of Justice?
