Subject: Accommodation of refugees in Hungary

Directive 2013/33/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council strengthens the rights of those seeking protection within an EU Member State. In the directive, the Member States commit themselves to ensure the protection of refugees while they are staying in a Member State and to comply with accommodation standards.

1. How will the Commission ensure that Directive 2013/33/EU is applied and complied with in connection with the accommodation of refugees in Hungary?
2. Is the Commission aware of instances in which representatives of human rights and refugee organisations have been refused access to refugee accommodation facilities?
