Subject: Refugees' rights

The Protocols of 10 December 1948 and 10 July 1951 relating to internationally-recognised rights of refugees enshrine the principle that human beings shall enjoy human rights and fundamental freedoms without discrimination. According to media sources, some of the conditions in which refugees are being held are not exactly desirable and fail to respect human rights principles. Can the Commission state:

1. Whether it has any data on the situation of refugees in the EU Member States, where the number of refugees continues to rise?
2. Whether, given that some refugee camps are situated outside population centres, it has considered ways in which these refugees can reintegrate into society?
3. Whether it plans to frame an EU-level integration policy?
