Subject: Camposol

Further to my written question of March 2013, I have been informed that the situation in Camposol has improved little since then, and in many cases deteriorated even further.

As has been brought to my attention, over 200 of the 3 500+ properties have been built on unstable ground, causing substantial cracking to private properties and fracturing sewer runs, which has in turn allowed raw sewage to escape and leak under roads and houses.

I have also been informed that several hundred properties were flooded in September 2014 because they had been illegally built on a natural watercourse that flooded. This has caused significant damage to houses in the area.

I therefore ask for clarification on the responses of the Spanish authorities with regard to the administrative letter sent out by the Commission in 2013.

Following on from this, I look forward to hearing what the Commission has done with regard to this since they received these responses.
