Question for written answer P-015087/2015 to the Commission Rule 130 Francesc Gambús (PPE)

Subject: Follow-up to Written Question P-013109/2015

In priority Written Question P-013109/2015 I asked what steps would be taken to ensure that similar situations that could harm the reputation of the European institutions did not occur again in future. In its reply, which was submitted two months later, the Commission confined itself to stating that 'measures have been taken to avoid similar errors in the future'.

In view of the special circumstances involved here, can the Commission say:

- 1. exactly what steps have been taken to avoid similar errors in future;
- 2. whether it has made changes to the procedures or circuits for answers to parliamentary questions in order to ensure that similar situations do not occur again;
- 3. whether it believes that the steps taken will be enough?
