Subject: Bringing national laws into line with Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council

Fundamental to the consolidation of the EU single market is the harmonisation of laws in all the Member States. Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products and repealing Council Directive 89/106/EEC was adopted with that aim in mind. Two years have passed since the regulation came fully into force.

Has the Commission investigated whether all the Member States have brought their national laws into line with the requirements set out in the regulation?

If so, will it publish its findings from that investigation?
