Subject: Transparency of Commission action as regards the complaint concerning the abuse of a dominant position by the Danish company VELUX

On 2 June 2016 the Commission answered my written question (P-003291-16) concerning a complaint against the Danish group VELUX for abuse of a dominant position. The Commission did not however provide any information on the state of play with regard to the proceedings, or on when they are likely to be concluded and in what form information on progress will be provided.

I should therefore like to enquire as to what the legal basis is for hitherto refusing to provide any information on this matter. Will this situation change? In what forms and when will information on the state of play with regard to the proceedings be made available? And when does the Commission intend to bring them to a close?
