Subject: Follow-up to written question P-007402/2016 on Flix

In its reply to written question P-007402/2016, the Commission states 'Member States are responsible for the implementation of EU legislation and the Commission does not possess the type of detailed information that the Honourable Member refers to'.

Given that the multi-faceted nature of the Flix case brings added complexity and notoriety, can the Commission, as the body responsible for overseeing the implementation of EU law, say what information it has with which to ascertain whether the water in the Flix reservoir and the adjacent land meet the current rules set out in the Water Framework Directive and the strategy for soil protection?

Can the Commission say what information has been provided by Spain for the purposes of budgetary accountability for the project to clean up the Flix reservoir, which was funded to the tune of 80% from the 2007-2013 operational programme, and when?

If this information is not yet available, when does it expect to have it?
