Subject: Support for the Pulse of Europe movement

Rallies with a high media profile are now taking place in many EU major cities under the slogan 'Pulse of Europe'. Meanwhile, the organiser of the Pulse of Europe citizens' initiative reports that over 70 cities in 11 countries have 'adopted' the slogan.

1. Is the Pulse of Europe movement financed either directly or indirectly from European Union funds, or has it received any such funding? If so, what are the sums involved and which institution do they come from?
2. Does the European Union or any agencies connected to it provide logistical or other help with the implementation or planning of the aforesaid rallies, or have they done so?
