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

- c) specific measures and objectives for the freshwater part of the life cycle of anadromous and catadromous species;

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- d) minimisation of impacts of fishing on the eco-system;
- e) safeguards and criteria activating those safeguards;
- f) any other measures suitable to achieve the objectives of multiannual plans.

The actions necessary to meet the objectives of a multiannual plan should be the responsibility of Member States cooperating on a regional basis. The last 6 points of the Commission's proposed Article 11 have therefore been moved to this new article highlighting Member State responsibilities.

The Commission shall publish conservation measures adopted according to this Article, and shall make this information publicly accessible by publishing it on appropriate websites or providing a direct link to it. With regard to access to environmental information, Regulations 1049/2001/EC and 1367/2006/EC shall apply.

Any natural or legal person

- (a) affected or likely to be affected by the decision or
- (b) having a sufficient interest in the decision or, alternatively,
- (c) alleging the impairment of a right, where administrative procedural law of a Member State requires this as a precondition

shall be entitled to ask the competent authority of a Member State for an internal review of a decision under this Article.

What constitutes a "sufficient interest" and "impairment of a right" shall be determined by the Member States.

To this end, the interest of any nongovernmental organisation promoting environmental protection or the economic or social interests of fishermen, and meeting any requirements under national law shall be deemed sufficient for the purpose of subparagraph (b). Such organisation shall also be deemed to have rights capable of being impaired for the purpose of subparagraph (c).

Against the decision of the competent authority, the persons mentioned in this

- paragraph shall have access to a court or other independent and impartial public body competent to review the procedural and substantive legality of the decision. The Member States shall determine the court or body which is competent to hear the case.
- 5. A Member State shall not be entitled to exercise any rights to any fishing opportunity which may apply to it, nor carry out any fishing activities in relation to the stocks and/or the relevant geographical area covered by a multiannual plan unless and until such time as conservation measures are either
- (a) agreed by an Interested Member State and enacted by way of national measures pursuant to this Article, or
- (b) adopted by the Commission pursuant to Article 20 and applicable to such Member State.
