Na. whereas the situation in Darfur and in the Blue Nile and South Kordofan regions is still extremely worrying; whereas on 23 October 2017 the Commission announced plans to make EUR 106 million available to ease the humanitarian crisis in Sudan; whereas provision of that aid is ‘conditional on the Khartoum Government guaranteeing humanitarian aid workers “unrestricted access”’; whereas on 6 November 2017 the President of Sudan announced that ‘the next stage is to clear the camps of displaced persons, because we don’t want any more displaced persons’ and accused the NGOs of ‘making money on the back of providing aid for displaced persons’, statements which coincided with the UN’s decision to reduce the strength of its UNAMID forces by almost half (44%);
