**Recital 1**

*Text proposed by the Commission*

(1) By Decision 2012/419/EU<sup>3</sup>, the European Council decided to amend the status of Mayotte with regard to the European Union with effect from 1 January 2014. Therefore, from that date Mayotte will cease to be an overseas territory and become an outermost region within the meaning of Articles 349 and 355(1) of **the** Treaty. Union law will apply to Mayotte as from that date. It is appropriate to provide for certain specific measures justified by the particular situation of Mayotte in a number of areas.

*Amendment*

(1) By Decision 2012/419/EU<sup>3</sup>, the European Council decided to amend the status of Mayotte with regard to the European Union with effect from 1 January 2014. Therefore, from that date Mayotte will cease to be an overseas **country or** territory **within the meaning of Article 198 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union** and become an outermost region within the meaning of Articles 349 and 355(1) of **that** Treaty. Union law will apply to Mayotte as from that date. It is appropriate to provide for certain specific measures, justified by the particular situation of Mayotte **and its new status as**

*an outermost region*, in a number of areas.
