The meeting opened at 10.07 on Tuesday, 3 September 2019, with Younous Omarjee. Chair, presiding.

1. Adoption of agenda

3. Chair's announcements

The Chair reported that, during the summer break, there had been many devastating fires in the Canary Islands and that he had sent a message of solidarity to the head of the regional government on behalf of the Committee on Regional Development. He also reported on the discussion in the most recent meeting of the Conference of Committee Chairs concerning committee hearings of Commissioners-designate. He said that the hearings for the Commissioners would take place during weeks 40 and 41, from 30 September to 8 October and that the vote on the entire Commission would be held in Strasbourg during the October session.

The meeting resumed at 15.07, with Younous Omarjee (Chair) presiding.

3 September 2019, 15.00 – 18.30

The Chair alerted Members to the fact that the coordinators had met at the end of the morning session and taken a number of decisions, which had subsequently been sent to the Members by e-mail for approval.

7. Introduction to the work of Policy Department B and presentation of a study "The agenda for cohesion policy in 2019-2024: Key issues for the REGI committee"

The Chair welcomed the guest speakers and gave the floor to:

- Johannes Litzelmann, Head of Unit, Policy Department for Structural and Cohesion policy
- Carlos Mendez, European Policies Research Centre Delft (EPRC Delft), lead researcher for the study

The presentations were followed by a question and answer session with Members.

8. Exchange of views with Marc Lemaître, Director-General for Regional and Urban Policy (REGIO), European Commission

Marc Lemaître, Director-General for Regional and Urban Policy, reported on the implementation of the current Cohesion Policy and responded to points made by Members.

9. Approval of coordinators' decisions

Since no objections were raised by Members, the coordinators' decisions are deemed to have been approved, namely that:

1. *Activities with national parliaments in the second half of 2019*

In response to the request of the Chair of the Conference of Committee Chairs, Mr Tajani, for the agenda of meetings with national parliaments for the remainder of 2019, the coordinators decided to follow the past procedure for meetings with national parliaments:

(i) Authorisations to hold inter-parliamentary meetings would be requested on a case-by-case basis when the time was right, and

(ii) REGI would continue to include, where possible, meetings with representatives of national parliaments in the programmes of all REGI missions.

2. Missions in second half of 2019 and first half of 2020

Missions in 2019

The coordinators decided to send 6 Members to Castilla-la-Mancha (Spain) in week 44, divided between the groups as follows:

EPP - 2; S&D - 2; Renew Europe - 1; GREENS - 1; ID - 0; ECR - 0; GUE/NGL - 0; Non-Attached (NI) - 0.

Missions in 2020

The coordinators agreed that the breakdown of the 25 REGI places on missions in 2020 would be as follows:

EPP - 7; S&D - 6; Renew Europe - 4; GREENS - 2; ID - 2; ECR - 2; GUE/NGL - 1; Non-Attached (NI) - 1.

The political groups were invited to send proposals to the REGI secretariat by 12 noon on Thursday 19 September: coordinators would then take a decision in their meeting on 2-3 October.

3. Points system for allocation of reports and opinions

The coordinators held an extensive debate on the merits of using the existing points system for the new parliamentary term:

- at the beginning of each half-term, each group receives 5 points for each full Member (each Non-Attached Member receives 5 points as an individual);
- groups pay 5 points each time they nominate a rapporteur; 2 points each time they nominate a rapporteur for opinion;
- the group which has most points remaining has first choice about whether or not it wishes to claim the next report/opinion to be allocated;
- the secretariat provides an updated points table after each coordinators' meeting;
- points which are not spent by the end of the half-term are lost;
- if a Member changes from one political group to another in the course of a parliamentary half-term, s/he is entitled to take to her/his new political group the number of points corresponding to the remaining portion of the half-term minus the points that s/he may have already used.

It was agreed that the Greens would circulate a proposal for a modified system; a final decision would be taken at the next meeting of the coordinators.

4. Public hearings in second half of 2019 and first half of 2020

The coordinators decided to continue with the current system for requesting authorisations for hearings. Instead of deciding on a programme in advance for each semester, the committee would proceed as follows:

- any suggestion for a hearing would be discussed by the coordinators on a case by case basis;
- if agreed, the Chair would write direct to the President one month in advance of the hearing date asking for authorisation to hold it.

It was underlined that hearings should only be held if sufficient attendance by Members could be guaranteed.

5. *Continuation of business: legislative dossiers*

With regard to the continuation of business, the Renew Europe group requested that a formal vote be held. The coordinators decided to follow the Chair's proposal by 34 votes in favour to 6 against (weighted by group size):

- The committee would not request a renewed referral for any of the six ongoing files, as this would cause undue delay;
- Concerning the use of the performance reserve, the committee would reiterate its request that the Commission should withdraw the proposal;
- All re-elected rapporteurs would be reappointed (Novakov and Krehl for the CPR, Cozzolino for the ERDF-CF, Arimont for Interreg)
- For the two ongoing files where the rapporteur had not been re-elected (ECBM and pre-financing), rapporteurs would be named by the groups in charge of those two files in the last term, without points being spent again. For the ECBM, Renew Europe would provide a name. For the pre-financing file, the rapporteur would be Andželika Anna Mozdżanowska (ECR).

6. *Calendar of REGI meetings 2020*

The coordinators approved the calendar of REGI meetings for 2020 as shown below. If required, extraordinary meetings would be held in Strasbourg, on Monday evenings (between 7 p.m. and 11 p.m.) and on Thursday mornings (9 a.m. - noon).

The coordinators decided that, in 2020, afternoon meeting sessions should commence at 15.00.

7. *Procedure for delegated and implementing acts*

The coordinators adopted the following rules on dealing with delegated and implementing acts:

I. Notification of draft delegated acts, implementing acts and measures under the regulatory procedure with scrutiny (RPS measures)

Once received from the Commission, the Secretariat will transmit (preliminary) draft delegated acts, implementing acts and RPS measures, as well as subsequent modifications, to the full committee, with the following information:

- a) the legal basis and procedure;
- b) a brief explanation of the draft act;
- c) whether an objection or extension is possible;
- d) the deadline for objection or extension.

II. Consideration of draft delegated acts

Draft delegated acts are put on the agenda of the following committee meeting for presentation by the Commission. Following the presentation and an exchange of views, Members may request a vote on a possible objection to the draft delegated act, or on an extension to the period for consideration. If the act is urgent, the committee may also vote on an early non-objection. In the absence of any requests for objection, extension or early non-objection, consideration of the draft delegated act will be closed.

Where the committee's agenda does not allow for a draft delegated act to be considered in a committee meeting, the decision on objection, extension or early non-objection can be taken by the coordinators by written procedure.

In the event of an objection, extension or early non-objection, the Secretariat will prepare a draft resolution (or letter) and circulate it to the coordinators for approval by written procedure.

III. Consideration of draft implementing acts

Draft implementing acts are not normally put on the agenda of committee meetings. However, an implementing act may be put on the agenda of the next committee meeting in exceptional circumstances, for example if it seems that the draft implementing act exceeds the implementing powers conferred in the basic act or is otherwise legally unsound (Rule 112(2) of the Rules of Procedure). Members may request a vote on a possible objection to a draft implementing act. Where necessary, such a decision can also be taken by the coordinators by written procedure.

In the event of an objection, the Secretariat will prepare a draft resolution and circulate it to the coordinators for approval by written procedure. Parliament resolutions objecting to

implementing acts have no legal effect.

IV. Consideration of draft measures under the regulatory procedure with scrutiny (RPS measures)

Very occasionally, draft RPS measures are received. RPS measures are a specific category of implementing act adopted on the basis of pre-Lisbon Treaty provisions, where Parliament has a right of objection. Draft RPS measures are not normally put on the agenda of committee meetings. However, an RPS measure may be put on the agenda of the next committee meeting in exceptional circumstances, for example if it seems that the draft RPS measure exceeds the implementing powers conferred in the basic act (Rule 112(4) of the Rules of Procedure). Members may request a vote on a possible objection to a draft implementing act. Where necessary, such a decision can also be taken by the coordinators by written procedure.

In the event of an objection, the Secretariat will prepare a draft resolution and circulate it to the coordinators for approval by written procedure.

V. Expert group and comitology meetings

Expert groups and comitology committees are composed of Member State and other experts. These groups are a forum for concertation between the Commission and the Member States before the adoption of delegated and implementing acts.

The REGI Secretariat normally receives invitations to the following expert group and comitology meetings:

- a) Expert Group on European Structural and Investment Funds (EGESIF);
- b) Expert Group on Territorial Cooperation and Urban Matters (EGTCUM);
- c) Expert Group on Delegated and Implementing Acts for the European Structural and Investment Funds (EGDIA)
- d) Coordination Committee for the European Structural and Investment Funds (COESIF).

Where relevant to the committee's work, a member of the Secretariat will attend the meetings and draw up a brief report. The Secretariat will circulate the reports and all documents considered at the meetings to the full committee.

VI. Archiving

The REGI Secretariat will keep electronic copies of all relevant documents.

8. Any other business

The Chair reported that he had received a letter from Mr Barnier, EU negotiator on the withdrawal of the United Kingdom, offering to come to a committee meeting to discuss the impact of Brexit in the area of regional policy.

The coordinators decided that Mr Barnier should be invited to speak to the committee before Brexit day (31 October), in order to hear his views on the consequences of Brexit.

On the Chair's proposal, the coordinators also decided to appoint one or two special rapporteurs on Brexit who would follow the matter on behalf of the committee.
