- **☑** Vote in ENVI on draft motion for a resolution (one vote): 16th March 2011

C.1. Timing of planned ENVI hearings/workshops and delegations in 2011

The papers for the meeting included note from secretariat on the timing of hearings/workshops and delegations in 2011.

Decision

The coordinators approved in principle the proposed timing of the committee's hearings, workshops and delegations.

The secretariat was instructed

- to explore alternative dates for the delegation to Turkey
- to organise the delegation to Poland during the second half of the turquoise week in May and
- to circulate a reminder on the practical application of the rules on Members' participation in delegations (in particular: application of the rolling d'Hondt system)

C.2.Confirmation of ENVI meeting scheduled for 28 February 2011

The meeting of 28 February 2011, p.m., was one of the meetings initially ear-marked as a possible additional meeting.

Decision

In view of the heavy workload (hearing on moving beyond 20% GHG emissions), the coordinators confirmed to hold a committee meeting on that date.

C.3. Possible ENVI contributions to a plenary resolution on the EU 2020 Strategy

Decision

The coordinators agreed to adopt a limited number of ENVI contributions in a *written* procedure on the basis of the Resource efficiency flagship initiative which is to be presented on 26 January 2011. The secretariat was instructed to make a proposal to this effect. The deadline for reactions to the draft would be no later than the 31st of January.

Decision

The coordinators decided that the Commission should be invited to the Environment Committee in order to comment the study and to report about possible progress and agreed that the request a *legislative* own-initiative report on the strengthening and clarification of certain requirements under the End-of Live Vehicles Directive should be considered in the light of the outcome of that presentation.

C.6. Request to the EEA - proposal from Mr Davies

Decision

The coordinators decided that the above request should be submitted to the European Environment Agency. The request will be circulated by the secretariat for possible comments.

C.7. Oral Question on Prevention of natural and man made disasters

Decision

The coordinators decided that the above question from the GUE/NGL Group should be tabled in the form of an Oral Question in plenary, following approval by the full committee (Rule 115).

Decision

The coordinators decided to take the above question as an Oral Question in committee (Rule 197).
