#### C. DECISIONS ON OTHER ISSUES

# C.1. Structured dialogue 2011 - implementation of the Commission Work Programme 2011, ENVI priorities for CWP 2012

The papers for the meeting included a letter of 9 March 2011 from Mr Lehne as well as a form.

#### **Decision**

The coordinators instructed the secretariat to submit a draft list, circulate it for comments and finalise a proposal in a meeting with political group staff. The coordinators would then take a final decision on the draft proposal at their next meeting .

#### C.2. Revision of the Drinking Water Directive

The papers for the meeting included letter of 3 February 2011 from Commissioner Potočnik on the revision of the Drinking Water Directive.

#### **Decision**

The coordinators invited the chairman to write to the Commissioner and to invite the Commission to the committee for further explanations.

#### C.3. Workshop on the Seveso III Directive

#### **Decision**

The coordinators decided to organise a workshop on the Seveso III Directive, taking place outside a formal committee meeting, to be financed from the committee's expertise budget. The detailed specifications shall be agreed upon in a follow-up written procedure.

#### C.4. Proposal to invite EIB President Maystadt to an ENVI meeting

#### **Decision**

The coordinators decided to invite the President of the European Investment Bank, Mr Philippe Maystadt, to a future ENVI meeting in order to discuss EIB support for the coal industry and its role in meeting the 2020 GHG reductions and energy savings targets.

#### C.5. Budget 2012: ENVI contributions

#### **Decision**

The coordinators took note of the procedural arrangements applying to (a) the EP Resolution on the Mandate for the Trilogue on the 2012 Draft Budget and (b) pilot projects and preparatory actions. That information shall be circulated by email to all ENVI Members

#### C.6. Sustainable energy prize 2011

The papers for the meeting included a letter of 18 February 2011 from Mr Rübig to Mr Leinen on the Sustainable Energy Prize 2011.

#### **Decision**

The coordinators invited the chairman to represent the ENVI committee on the coordination group for the Sustainable Energy Prize award ceremony.

#### C.7. Ad-hoc delegation to Calabria (river, sea and soil contamination)

The papers for the meeting included letter of 15 January 2011 to Mr Leinen from Ms McAvan on toxic waste in the valley of the river Oliva as well as further documentation on this issue.

#### **Decision**

The coordinators decided to ask the Conference of Presidents to authorise the sending of an ad-hoc delegation to Calabria.

#### **Decision**

The coordinators noted that the hearing on Rio+20 would take place on 25 May and the hearing on the Baltic Sea on 21 June.

#### **Decision**

The coordinators noted that due to calendar constraints the delegation would take place on 1-2 September. The groups were invited to provide the secretariat with names of interested Members

The coordinators decided to request authorisation for a delegation to ECDC. The coordinators noted the tentative timing (1-2 September 2011). The groups were invited to provide the secretariat with names of interested Members

*C.11.1 - Preliminary information on delegation to Turkey* 

#### **Decision**

Since general elections had been called for 12 June 2011, the coordinators decided to postpone the mission to Turkey until after summer break (i.e. after the appointment of the new Government), tentatively in October (October 5-7, or 10-11, or turquoise week (Week 44))

C.11.2. - Preliminary information on delegation to Poland

#### **Decision**

The coordinators noted that the delegation would take place on 18-20 May 2011. The groups were invited to provide the secretariat with names of interested Members

#### C.12 Mediator - request by Ms Hassi to invite French inspectorate "IGAS" to ENVI

#### **Decision**

The coordinators

- recalled their previous decision of 17 February 2011 ("The coordinators decided to invite representatives of the EMA and of the European Commission to present the matter at a future committee meeting.")
- agreed on the basis of Rule 193(2) that the "Inspection générale des affaires sociales" (IGAS<sup>3</sup>) should also be invited to the exchange of views so as to complement the presentations to be given by the European Commission and the EMA by presenting also the IGAS report<sup>4</sup> on "Médiator".

#### C.13. ENVI debate on the Commission's ILUC report - request by Ms Hassi

#### **Decision**

#### The coordinators

- recalled that ITRE had been the lead committee for the Renewable Energy Directive whereas ENVI had been the lead committee for the Fuel Quality Directive;
- noted that both Directives require the Commission to report to the European Parliament and to the Council by 31 December 2010, reviewing the impact of indirect land-use change on greenhouse gas emissions and addressing ways to minimise that impact<sup>5</sup>; and that the report should, if appropriate, be accompanied by a proposal, based on the best available scientific evidence, containing a concrete methodology for emissions from carbon stock changes caused by indirect land-use change<sup>6</sup>;
- decided to invite the Commission to a future committee meeting (May) in order to present its report on indirect land-use change related to biofuels and bioliquids (COM(2010) 811 of 22.12.2010).

## C.14. Authorisation of two workshops proposed by the ENVI Health Working Group

#### **Decision**

The coordinators noted that the Health Working Group had requested to organise two workshops (respectively on "Health In All Policies (HIAP) approach: Developing synergies with all sectors is crucial for a strong Community health policy" and on "Rare Cancers: The added value of closer co-operation").

The details shall be agreed in a follow-up written procedure.

# C.15. Statements by Ms Harms in relation to Commissioner Oettinger's appearance before the ENVI committee on 16 March 2011

The coordinators heard Ms Hassi, Coordinator of the Greens/EFA Group, who explained the background of a statement made by Ms Harms at the beginning of the ENVI meeting on 17 March 2011 in relation to the alleged consequences of Mr Oettinger's appearance before the ENVI committee the day before. The coordinators held an exchange of views, noted that Ms Harms had not been present at the hearing with Mr Oettinger and reached the conclusion that the Environment Committee was not the competent body for giving any follow-up to Ms Harms's statement.

Article 7d(6) of Directive 2009/30/EC and Article 19(6) of Directive 2009/28/EC

The requirement in the Renewable Energy Directive also applies to bioliquids.
