C. DECISIONS ON OTHER ISSUES

C.1. Exchange of views with Ms Roth-Behrendt, contact person for relations with the EMA, on alleged conflicts of interest

Decision

The coordinators

- heard Ms Roth-Behrendt, the ENVI contact person for relations with the agency;
- held an exchange of views;
- took note of the information provided by Ms Roth-Behrendt on the case of Mr Lönngren, former Executive Director of the EMA;
- took note of the information provided by Ms Roth-Behrendt in relation to Professor Holomaň, who had been appointed by the European Parliament to the Management Board of the EMA as substitute member and concluded that a letter should be addressed to Professor Holomaň in order to
 - o ask him for clarifications regarding his alleged conflict of interests;
 - o inform him that he may be invited to respond to those allegations in a hearing:
 - o point out that on the basis of Article 7 of the applicable rules³ the Conference of Presidents as the authority responsible had the power to withdraw the mandate of representatives who fail to fulfil the obligations of their office.

C.2. Structured dialogue 2011 - implementation of the Commission Work Programme 2011, ENVI priorities for CWP 2012

Decision

The persons designated shall refrain from any act incompatible with or prejudicial to the exercise of their mandates. The Conference of Presidents may withdraw the mandate from any person who fails to fulfil the obligations of his office or violates the principles of impartiality or independence. The person concerned shall be given a prior hearing."

C.3. Comitology: Fukushima/food decision(s) of the Commission- Implementing act on feed and food from Japan following the Fukushima accident

The papers for the meeting included an information note dated 8 April 2011.

Decision

Given that (a) the first draft had entered into force on 27 March as Regulation 297/2011 and (b) no objections had been received in relation to the revised draft which was adopted on Monday 11 April, the coordinators decided not to apply the procedure provided for by Rule 88.

The coordinators instructed the chair to address a letter to the European Commission in order to demand that lower maximum radioactive levels for food and feed than those laid down in Regulation (Euratom) 3954/87 be set on the basis of the TFEU through the ordinary legislative procedure. The draft letter would be circulated for comments.

<u>C.4. Request to draw up a resolution on the problem of nuclear safety 25 years after the Chernobyl accident - proposal by Mr Sonik</u>

Decision

The coordinators agreed that an Oral Question (without resolution) should be drawn up on the basis of Rule 115. Mr Sonik was invited to submit a draft Oral Question.
