

## **Bruce C. Swartz**

### **United States Department of Justice**

Bruce C. Swartz is a Deputy Assistant Attorney General, and the Department of Justice's Counselor for International Affairs. He is a member of the Senior Executive Service of the United States Government.

Mr. Swartz supervises the Department of Justice's Office of International Affairs, as well as the Department's Office of Overseas Prosecutorial Development, Assistance and Training (OPDAT) and the International Criminal Investigative Training Assistance Program (ICITAP).

Prior to joining the Department of Justice, Mr. Swartz was a partner at the Washington, D.C., law firm of Shea & Gardner. He has held a number of positions in government service, including Deputy Independent Counsel in the corruption investigation of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development during the Reagan Administration. In the mid-1990s, Mr. Swartz was detailed for a year to the United Kingdom's Serious Fraud Office.

Mr. Swartz received his B.A. and J.D. from Yale University and was a Henry Fellow at Trinity College, Cambridge University. He was a Law Clerk to Justice Harry Blackmun of the United Supreme Court, and to Judge Wilfred Feinberg of the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit. He is a member of the Bar of New York and the District of Columbia and is a Barrister (Middle Temple, England).

Mr. Swartz is a recipient of the Presidential Distinguished Rank Award, and of the Criminal Division's Henry R. Petersen Memorial Award.
