The Nordic - Baltic cooperation - a panel discussion focusing on the expanding business opportunities in the Baltic region

The year of 2016 has brought along many uncertainties. The trends in 2017 seems unusually difficult to predict. It is still uncertain what policies Donald Trump will implement and what impact it will have on global market. The previously fast growing economy of China is slowing down and continued war in the Middle East. We are also facing political uncertainties in Europe with many crucial elections to come this year. In addition to this, the uncertainty of Brexit and the consequences to come still remains. In regard to the uncertainties, it is essential to promote Estonia as a stable and lower risk business environment.

Despite the concerns there is still a lot to be mentioned on the optimistic side. During 2017 we will start to see driverless cars on the streets. Other trends in tech such as artificial intelligence, Internet of things and the development of 5G networks are expected to expand significantly in the market. We should emphasize that Estonia is a great place to test or develop new technologies and also tell the stories about the companies already doing so.

There has been some (not so positive) media coverage of the Baltic countries in Sweden regards to security issues. Instead, we want to show the image of Estonia as an innovative and technological country, such as Estonia's ability to handle cyber-attacks successfully.

The general knowledge of Estonia in Sweden is relatively low. We need to tell the story about e-Estonia and e-Residency, advantages in business environment, culture and financial attractiveness. The best way to achieve this is together with the other Baltic countries, since the region is strategically important for the Swedish companies and we will always be compared with each other. Promoting Estonia together with the other Baltic countries will benefit Estonia as we gain more attention since the opportunity to participate at this event came through the cooperation between the Baltic representatives. However, it is still an opportunity to introduce Estonia's strengths and what we have to offer. One of our main strengths is the ICT sector and the digital society which will be the Estonia's main focus in the panel. Latvia will focus on manufacturing and Lithuania on shared services, but still emphasizing that all three of the countries are strong in each of the mentioned sectors. The selected focus of Estonia is also in line with the strategy to target more value added jobs.
