ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

I own a half share of my home at 4 Higher Kinders, Greenfield, Oldham, and of my flat at Rue Gray 62, Brussels.

I have some small shareholdings, the largest of which (purchased over time for a total of £12,500) is in Good Energy, a UK renewable electricity supplier. None of these give me particular influence within the companies concerned and I do not believe they are of sufficient value to have public policy implications.

The Liberal Democrats' North West Regional Party rents desk space at the office I lease at 87a Castle Street, Stockport SK3 9AR. This income defrays the cost of occasional communications undertaken on its behalf.

Payments from the European Parliament for office-related expenses are made into a 'General Expenditure' account, the details of which are verified annually by an accountant and published on my website.

A summary of the expenses and allowances I receive from the Parliament is published annually on my website.

I do not employ a member of my family and have never done so. I declare that the allowance paid by the Parliament towards staff costs is used for the purpose for which it is intended.

I am a member of the Parliament's voluntary pension scheme and made contributions to it from 1999 to 2009.
