**"CHANGING THE HOUSING CONDITIONS OF LUANDA  
MUSSEQUES (SHANTY TOWNS)"**

**According to the Government Programme related to the Millennium Development Goals, the Republic of Angola set forth as a priority the reduction of the number of people without access to basic sanitation and proper housing.**

**Luanda, a city that was previously built for only 300,000 inhabitants, has today more than five million people, which puts huge pressure on the urban equipments linked to infrastructures.**

**The Angolan authorities are working on the delivery of basic services to the population, specially the youth, through the construction of infrastructures and housing projects.**

**However, it is underway an ambitious program for the urban re-planning and the building of about one million houses, through the national territory.**
