Prospective systems for aviation communications above 960MHz, which help *fulfil* Community policy objectives in this sector, **and other terrestrial systems capable of providing electronic communications services that can co-exist with GSM and UMTS below 960MHz**, should be taken into account. CEPT has produced technical advice in respect **of the first of these cases**.
