

Results of the Referendum on the approval of the new Constitution of the Republic of Serbia ^{1 2}

Republic's Election Commission (RIK) presented, on the XXI session held on November 2nd, 2006, the final results of the referendum on the approval of the new Constitution of the Republic of Serbia.

According to the final results, 53, 04% of the total number of voters voted in favour of the new Constitution.

The referendum took place on November 28 and 29, 2006, in 8.401 voting places in the Republic of Serbia and in 40 voting places abroad.

RIK confirmed that the referendum on the approval of the new Constitution was successfully carried out in line with the Law on referendum and the national initiative, and it has proclaimed the results of the referendum valid.
